The American Education & Exchange Association describes a host family as “culture coaches, helping students integrate into an American lifestyle so that they can be comfortable in their studies. But the most important function that Host Families serve is to be their friends! Being away from home is hard, no matter where you are from. When Host families treat their students as their own, a bond develops between them that is fulfilling and enduring.”
