

## STUDENT TUITION & FEES 2018 – 2019

**Returning Families:**

- The 2018-19 enrollment fee for returning students is \$135 per student if paid by February 28<sup>th</sup>.
- **Returning students who enroll for 2018-19 after February 28<sup>th</sup> will pay \$230 (which includes the new student application fee of \$95 and the enrollment fee of \$135), and be accepted on a space-available basis.**
- A non-refundable administrative fee of \$495 per family is due May 1<sup>st</sup> for returning families.

**New Families:**

- New students (including siblings who are new), pay a non-refundable \$95 application fee per student.
- New students (including siblings who are new), pay a non-refundable \$135 enrollment fee upon acceptance.
- New families pay the non-refundable \$495 administrative fee upon acceptance. This holds the student's place in the classroom and allows us to plan for the new school year.

**Fees (application, enrollment and administrative fees) are non-refundable.**

**Tuition Payments:**

- Tuition paid in full by July 1<sup>st</sup> will receive a 1% discount.
- Automatic tuition payments set up by the school are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> or 15<sup>th</sup> of each month, July through April.
- Tuition payments initiated by you (paid by check, cash or online) are due on the first day of each month, July through April. **You will also pay a \$50 annual (once a year) billing fee.** Payments received after the 10th of each month are considered late and will be assessed a **\$10 late fee per student.**
- If a student is withdrawn prior to the end of the school year, only the tuition through the end of the month of withdrawal will be due.

**Refunds:** The Ambrose School Program hires and plans financially during January through May of each year, committing resources for the following year. For this reason, we must make parts of our tuition/fee payments non-refundable to encourage commitment. The application fee, enrollment fee, and administrative fee are not refundable. The first two tuition payments are not refundable. The remaining tuition payments are refundable ONLY if the student does not attend any part of that month.

**Notes:**

- The child in the highest grade will pay full tuition. Each successive child is given the corresponding discount.
- Heritage and International student tuition is not represented on this chart.
- Tuition and fees are only one source of revenue for the school. The actual cost of an education is subsidized by tax-deductible donations to The Ambrose School.
