PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Letters Courses

Our Letters courses integrate the history, literature, philosophy, theology and art of a time period and serve as the foundation of our program. Students read the great works of Western thought and engage with the great questions of human experience through Socratic discussions.

Summa Courses

In Summa Theologica students study orthodox Christian theology. In Summa Civitas, students learn political theory and American government.

Writing and Rhetoric Courses

Freshmen in Writer's Rhetoric focus on written persuasion. Sophomores in Classical Rhetoric practice persuasion through public speaking. In our Junior Thesis and Senior Thesis courses, students research an area of interest, develop an argument with strong evidence, and defend their position in a lengthy paper and in an oral defense before a panel of judges.

Preceptorials and Teaching Apprenticeships

Our one-credit **Preceptorial** courses are electives on a wide variety of subjects. **Teaching Assistantships** give students experience helping in a classroom, and our Teaching Apprenticeship students teach and help run a classroom.
